Properly Moving Your Antique Slot Machine (for Either a Short or Long Distance)

Mechanical

- remove metal backdoor, leave key in lock on door, tape down securely
- remove bonnet
- remove coin box
- remove mechanism from casing
- wrap the first four above items separately in plastic, then place in a heavy-duty cardboard box with padding
- with another person helping you, place the casing standing up in another large box in the vehicle
- transport all items in a covered vehicle in a back seat area; do not expose to any weather
- use seat belts, tie downs (highly advised), if possible

Electromechanical

- open door
- remove reel assembly
- remove top glass (if present)
- remove hopper
- close door and lock it, tape the key to the door outside
- wrap the reel assembly in plastic
- wrap the top glass in a heavy towel or blanket
- wrap the hopper in plastic
- place the reel assembly, hopper and top glass in a large cardboard box, padded with towels or blankets
- with two or three people helping you, place the casing standing up and seat-belted or tied down in the vehicle to be transported; do NOT lay it down!
- transport the other items in a covered vehicle in a back seat area; do not expose to any weather
- use seat belts, tie downs (highly advised), if possible

Video

- open door
- remove hopper
- remove main processing unit, wrap in plastic
- remove any glass (if possible)
- place a blanket or heavy towels around the video screen
- close door, tape key to the door outside
- with two or three people helping you, place the casing standing up and seat-belted or tied down in the vehicle to be transported; do NOT lay it down!
- transport the other items in a covered vehicle in a back seat area; do not expose to any weather
- use seat belts, tie downs (highly advised), if possible

Electronic

- open door
- remove hopper
- remove any glass
- remove reel assembly (if not possible, place a blanket or heavy towels around the assembly)
- close door, tape key to the door outside
- with two or three people helping you, place the casing standing up and seat-belted or tied down in the vehicle to be transported; do NOT lay it down!
- transport the other items in a covered vehicle in a back seat area; do not expose to any weather
- use seat belts, tie downs (highly advised), if possible

Drive your vehicle carefully, observing all vehicle code laws!
